DB Control inks \$7.8M in defense contracts, buys Fremont building

<u>DB Control</u> on Tuesday said it has landed \$7.8 million in contracts for military equipment and has bought an adjacent building in Fremont to accommodate expansion.

DB Control, a manufacturer of microwave amplifiers, radar transmitters and power supplies, said it made the deals with major defense contractors supplying equipment to the U.S. Army, Navy and Air Force. Under various contracts it will supply amplifiers, power modules and radar equipment for both airborne and shipborne applications.

The Fremont company also said it has acquired a nearby building at 1100 Auburn Street increasing its space from 25,500 square feet to 40,000 square feet. Financial details of the purchase were not disclosed.
